Libertarian Presidential Candidate To Speak At the University of Florida

GAINESVILLE, Fla. – Libertarian Party Presidential Candidate, Bob Barr, will be speaking on Sept. 23, in the J. Wayne Reitz Student Union Amphitheatre at the University of Florida. This event is free and open to the public. There will be a press conference at 6:30 p.m. The event begins at 7:00 p.m., with an introduction by Karl Dickey, a Patrick Henry impersonator.

Barr is best known for his time served in the U.S. House of Representatives, where he represented the 7th District of Georgia. From 1995 to 2003, he served as a senior member of the Judiciary Committee, Vice-Chairman of the Government Reform Committee and as a member of the Committee on Financial Services. Barr now practices law with the Offices of Edwin Marger, and runs a consulting firm, Liberty Strategies LLC.

The event is sponsored by the UF College Libertarians and ACCENT Speakers Bureau. The UF College Libertarians are a student-run campus group that seeks to spread the ideals of liberty and self-ownership. The UF College Libertarians were founded in the 1980's with the aim of to work closely with libertarian groups throughout the county, the state and the nation in order to bring a comprehensive pro-freedom message to the University of Florida campus.
