

**STUDENT SENATE BILL 2009-1041**

**TITLE: Authorization Directing Chomp the Vote Director Brett Roth to Immediately Fulfill His Statutory Duties**

WHEREAS, there will be a Gainesville city election on March 24, 2009, and Early Voting began March 16, 2009; and

WHEREAS, in the March 24, 2009 election two members of the Gainesville City Commission, from At-Large 1 and District 1, will be elected; and two amendments to the City Charter will appear on the ballot, namely Charter Amendment 1, "Prohibiting the City from Providing Certain Civil Rights," and Charter Amendment 2, "Protection of City-owned Lands Acquired or Used for Conservation, Recreation, or Cultural Purpose"; and

WHEREAS, Chomp the Vote is an agency of Student Government charged with carrying out voter registration, education, and mobilization; and

WHEREAS, Chomp the Vote, under Executive Director Brett Roth, appears to have conducted little or no work relating to the upcoming city elections, THEN  
Chomp the Vote Executive Director Brett Roth is hereby ordered to immediately begin carrying out his duties outlined in Student Body Statutes and to render to the Student Senate a full written account of the work of Chomp the Vote relating to the March 24, 2009 city election, within 30 days of the passage of this authorization.
